#### Size

When determining size of your co-op consider cost per family, number of teachers needed, and size of your co-op space.

### Cost per family:

Divide your costs by number of families. If your cost for a year is \$1000, you will need ten families to keep costs to \$100/family.

#### Number of teachers:

If you are offering three periods a day and splitting kids into three groups (little, medium, big), you will need a bare minimum of nine teachers. If you want co-teachers, you will need eighteen.

#### Size of co-op space:

How many rooms do you have available? How many tables and chairs do you have available? How many tables and chairs can fit in a room?
